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SENATOR COORDSEN: I'm afraid I did not hear who you wish to ask a question.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, the Speaker, I'm sorry.

SENATOR COORDSEN: All right. There is the Speaker. I was in terror that you had spoken about me and I'm not the Speaker. So, Senator Kristensen, would you respond to a question, please?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Kristensen, this motion says to bracket until January 5, of the year 2000.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If this motion were to be successful and at some point farther in the session you deemed it essential that this bill be brought back to the agenda, would you have the authority to do that?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: And it's bracketed till January?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You wouldn't?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: If we could...I could make a motion to unbracket though.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then I stand corrected. I thought the Speaker by...under his discretion could do it. I'm glad that he corrected that.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: But he could...you could have a motion to unbracket. I don't know how that's going to play, but it's bracketed to a date certain, is that correct?
