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SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay, thank you very much. I am going to support Senator Brown's amendment to this. I'm not as optimistic as many of you are as to what the feds will do. And I do think, even though I think it is an obligation of clerk of the district courts to do their job now, one of the reasons the feds introduced the incentives several years ago, as I recall, in fact a long time ago, some incentives have been...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...put into place. I think it may well be that it's going to take some reminder, if you will, that they're going to have to continue to provide for child support collection and to do their duties, not so much that they won't do them, but there isn't much incentive to do when you have a tremendous workload. And I've seen that happen in the past that there needs to be encouragement because of the workload. And some things just simply through the cracks, you don't do it in eight hours a day, by my observation. And you don't put in overtime and overtime and overtime making these...doing this book work, and that's the reason for the original federal legislation, as I recall it. So I'm going to support the amendment. It makes...it's a safety net. I think it also is realistic to the fact that these are not easy duties to do. It does take lots of extra time.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Time. Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members of the Legislature, I don't support the Brown amendment because I think she's simply trying to make a point, nor do I support the Bohlke amendment as any sort of solution to the problem that we're faced with. Obviously, striking all amendments, striking all provisions of the bill and merely seeking a waiver is not going to satisfy the federal government requirements that are statutory in nature and is simply the equivalent of forfeiting the \$15 million or whatever it is we would lose. But I think all of these ideas, and perhaps there is value to the waiver thing, if that helps us advance it to Select File and buys us breathing time to discuss this, but I think there are ways that
