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interjected into a criminal case, I think a lot of folks believe that, well,...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR HILGERT: ...if I buy a great lawyer, if I have enough money, my chances are better. Is that fair? I know most Nebraskans are for the death penalty, and I would agree with Senator Bruning that these individuals deserve it. But Nebraskans, beyond being for the death penalty, I believe are fair. Now if we look at this moratorium and we study this, what harm is there in looking at the reality of the way that the death penalty is imposed in the state of Nebraska? The wheels of justice keep on turning. Individuals are still...will be sentenced to death. Why should we be afraid of what the result of a study might be? If you...are you...do some members believe that if we study the...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Time.

SENATOR HILGERT: ...death penalty.... I didn't hear the one minute.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I want to...oh, I see Senator Hilgert has his light on, so he will have more time. Here's what I wish we could keep in mind, what Justice Douglas said about the Rosenbergs. It's more effective when I read it, even though I've read it so many times I could quote it backward, forward, or starting at the middle and going both ways. No harm would be done. The Rosenbergs were behind bars. They could be executed in October, as well as in June. I heard everything Senator Bruning said and his argument is the one that people often give who are for the death penalty--I feel a certain way and, therefore, people out to die. Maybe all of our families have been touched by murder. Mine has been, and they'll never catch the ones who murdered my nephew. Never. They don't even care. And it was a brutal murder. He was shot so many times in the head that the coffin could not be open. But I'm not like Senator Bruning. My sleep is going to be disturbed because somebody did a terrible deed. Maybe I have
