SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Brashear, under this amendment, the amendment we're talking about now is what? What is this amendment?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: The amendment we're talking about now is...it has the E clause, so the bill will be effective upon the Governor signing it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And that's all that Senator Dierks' amendment will do that we're voting on now?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: No, no. This amendment removes one word, as Senator Dierks fully and completely explained it in his brief opening.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Which I missed, because I was in another consultation, so I'm...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: I'm sorry. He is fulfilling a commitment made to other members on the floor to remove the word "employee," as I recall it, please nod, Senator Dierks, if I've got this correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, so...so this amendment that he's offering now has nothing to do with that which you brokered earlier?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: That's correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then that's the one that I want to talk to you about on, and not this particular one, so I won't take any time on this one.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Seeing no other lights, Senator Dierks waives closing. The question before us is the adoption of the Dierks amendment to LB 835. Those in favor say aye. Those op...excuse me. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record.
