SENATOR BROMM: ...than simply getting started. If it means getting started, I would think a county could get started between now and January 1, by appointing a commission and by retaining a consultant. A consultant is going to take time. In fact, these people are kind of hard to get, at least that's what I've been told by a couple of counties. And so I know there isn't...the answers aren't all there, but perhaps that can be discussed more, even if it's not on this amendment, as to what that means so we'd have some legislative interpretation of what our expectations are. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. (Visitors introduced.) Senator Chambers, on the Kremer amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I want to enter consultation just for a minute, but I know my time is running. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, what would you think if "Mr. A" was talking to "Ms. B" and "Mr. A" held to a position and "Ms. B" held the opposite position, then "Mr. A" persuaded "Ms. B" to take "Mr. A's" position but, in the meantime, "Mr. A" was persuaded to take "Ms. B's" position? That's strange, isn't it? Well, I talked to Senator Kremer off the mike and I'm persuaded now that his amendment is the appropriate thing to do. I was not going to support it. Now I am. If an effort is not made to begin doing this by January, then there's no intent to do anything. We are not, as I consider it, talking about brain surgery or that other thing they always use. Senator Smith, what it is, making fireworks or rockets? You don't need (laugh)...you don't need somebody to know how to make rockets to do this. So, in view of the fact that people who say they want to be able to put in place temporary zoning, they must see something that justifies that being done. And if to them the wolf is a thousand leagues over the sea, their view might be, we'll never have to do anything because the wolf is not going to get here. But I want to be able to start building a fence if the wolf happens to get close. Other people may say there have been different persons and groups who have been vigilant, who have been prudent and they've constructed their fences and, if the wolf does happen to come into your yard, you're going to ask everybody who's been prudent to take care of you and help overcome or mitigate the damage done by the wolf when you have had enough time to prepare and
