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flexibility to say you may do or you may not do what needs to be done. Somehow I'm...I'm having trouble, people may be having trouble with the A bill but then changing it to "may," I have certain...I can't support that. I mean why...why give them an employee and the money when we're trying to accomplish better testing and then turn around the "shall" to the "may?" I am sorry, Senator Schrock, that, I won't be able to be supportive of that unless there is something in this picture I'm not understanding. So with that, I'll give my time back to the Chair and I'll go discuss with Senator Schrock anything further.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Vrtiska on the Schrock amendment to the Beutler amendment.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. I'm not going to belabor...I'm not going to belabor this issue except repeat what Senator Bohlke has already said. I can't believe that we would give them \$150,000 and say, well, if you want to do it, okay; if you don't, spend the money for something else, basically. To me that's what it says. If I don't understand it, then I guess I need to talk to Senator Schrock but he's saying you may do it or you may not do it, and I...you know, Senator Bohlke has already described that and that's exactly my attitude, and so I can't support the amendment with that kind of wording in it. And with that, I'll again give you my time back. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. There are no more lights on. Senator Schrock, did you wish to close?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Cudaback and Senator Bohlke and Senator Vrtiska, I would like to have you listen as I read Section 6. Section 6 says: It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate one hundred fifty thousand dollars annually to the department for the purpose of enhancing the department's water quality monitoring programs to further the purposes of section 5 of this act. I think that gives pretty good direction and it also refers to Section 5. Quite frankly, I'd be comfortable, and Senator Beutler knows this, without Section 5, which includes all the things they should monitor. I think we should give DEQ the authority to monitor what they think is important for the quality of our streams, and Senator Beutler has listed that. But his...but his portion of that amendment
