SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, both of the remaining amendments have been adopted in different forms in other amendments, so I would withdraw them both.

SENATOR CUDABACK: They are withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, next item.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Schrock would move to amend. (FA112, Legislative Journal pages 1632-1633.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, and members of the Legislature, hopefully, this will be the last amendment that I will offer today on LB 822, but there's still some confusion as to the amendment we adopted earlier pertaining to the Livestock Waste Management Act, and this amendment clarifies that the zoning provisions that we've adopted in LB 822 apply only to LB 822. I hope that is clarifying what we're doing here because there was some concern that we were changing the whole Livestock Waste Management Act. We only want to make this amendment apply to the provisions that we have on the Livestock Waste Management Act in LB 822.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Open for discussion on the Schrock amendment to LB 822, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator, I don't see the amendment. Is it...oh, the amendment is now on the screen. Okay, thank you, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Anybody else wishing to speak to the amendment? Senator Schrock, to close. Senator Schrock waives closing. The question before the body is, shall the Schrock amendment to LB 822 be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Schrock's amendment.
