SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. President, members of the body, I concur with what Senator Schimek is doing. We've had these discussions on policy in the past on these specific issues. I concur with the two or three things in the bill that she's trying to do, as I understand them from DAS, and I urge your support of this amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Seeing no lights, Senator Schimek, would you like to close on your motion?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I would like to close, because I misspoke. This extends the temporary workers' benefits only one year instead of two years. So I wish to correct that for the record. It also has another little provision in there which I also didn't mention in my opening, and that is that it simply extends the department's authority to collective bargain in the future. So, we do that periodically. It's kind of pro forma, but I thought I should mention it anyway. With that, I would appreciate you returning this to Select.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Schimek. The question is, shall LB 113 be returned to Select File? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 34 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The motion is agreed to. Senator Schimek, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I won't go into any more detail unless there are any further questions. I appreciate your willingness to return this to Select and hope that you will adopt the amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Seeing no lights, you're recognized to close. Senator Schimek waives closing. The question is the adoption of Select File amendment to LB 113. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.
