SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I heard...did hear you say you were going to have to put in a General Fund request through the mainline budget. And I...you did say that, and I wanted to make that clear too...

SENATOR COORDSEN: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...that we can't appropriate through it a resolution. So...

SENATOR COORDSEN: That's correct.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...you...if this passes, why, you will have that tomorrow afternoon, I assume. So...

SENATOR COORDSEN: Well, I'll file it this morning. Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I wanted to make it clear to the body, so there was no confusion that we cannot appropriate through it a legislative resolution. And we'll be expecting the amendment if this passes. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. There being no other lights, Senator Schrock, would you like to close on the committee amendments? Senator Schrock closes...or, waives closing on the committee amendments. All those in favor of the committee amendments to LR 22 vote aye, those opposed nay. Have all who wish to voted? Please record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to. Discussion on the adoption of LR 22? Senator Coordsen, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. Again, I would indicate that this is a relatively small study. It may be a small problem, it may not be as small a problem as we think. There exist today...and an number of irrigators are already using a petroleum-based drip oil just
