I apologize to you for the drafting issue that I'm bringing to you but I do want to assure this is...this is exclusively a drafting issue and is necessary to make sense out of AM1478 in the context of what Senator Wehrbein wants to do with his amendment. So if I could just ask your indulgence in the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. For discussion on the amendment to AM1478. Senator Wehrbein, do you wish to speak to the amendment to the amendment?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Very briefly, Mr. President, members. I would support Senator Wickersham's amendment in this case. I will not support the next one, but I will, if it happens to go, it ought to be in the right condition. So, thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Redfield, on the amendment to the amendment. Senator Wickersham, you're recognized to close. He waives. The question before us is the amendment to AM1478 to LB 630. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment to the amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted. Further discussion on AM1478, Senator Redfield.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members of the body. I would ask Senator Wickersham a question, if I might.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Wickersham, would you yield?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Senator Wickersham, on your amendment, on page 8, Section 11, the sentence reads, the beginning farmer or livestock producer and owner of agricultural assets shall be entitled to a rental assistance benefit equal to five percent.
