CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

SENATOR CROSBY: The house is under call. Would all senators please record your presence. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Bohlke, Senator Brashear. Senator Bruning, Senator Hartnett, the house is under call. Senator Quandahl, Senator Robak. Senator Stuhr, Senator Thompson. Senator Landis. Senator Brashear, the house is under call. Senator Kremer, we are under call. You should be in your seat. Senator Connealy, you can sit down too. All present and accounted for, we are voting on the Wickersham amendment to LB 630. A roll call vote in reverse order has been requested. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Begins taking roll call vote in regular order.)

SENATOR BEUTLER: I wasn't sure whether the...the President had indicated reverse order or not.

SENATOR CROSBY: I did, yes, I did in reverse order, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Forgive me,...

SENATOR CROSBY: I'm sorry.

CLERK: ...Madam President. (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1704-1705.) I need to verify, Madam President. (Verified roll call vote.) 19 ayes, 18 nays on the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment fails. I will raise the call. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Redfield would move to amend. Senator, the very first amendment that you provided to me earlier today, FA116.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Withdraw that one, replace with FA120.
