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talking about currently is the operations cost, the \$19,294. We have had some discussion on the floor about the amount of money that we are spending on juveniles and whether we are spending sufficiently on our juvenile population, and this is an opportunity for us to talk about whether the money is best spent in this area and whether our...the changes in the numbers that we've had would justify the reconsideration of the work camp. The dirt has been turned, but construction has not started on the work camp, and so this would be a time when we really could reexamine it. But I think another reason that we might want to look at the work camp is around the issue of efficiency. When...when we first discussed the idea of the work camp, it was with the consideration that it would be done in close proximity...close proximity to another facility so that there could be some economies of scale and the use of employees from one facility to another and things, but the proposed location now eliminates that possibility. And so we have...the bulk of the money in that...that we're...not the bulk of the money but \$416,000 of the amount that I'm talking about in this amendment comes from additional probation staff that...because we are...we would need to have probation staff specifically in the location to address these individuals. So we may not be getting the full impact of the efficiencies that we wanted. A final issue is that a work camp does not address one of the issues around alternative corrections that we need to be concerned about, and that has to do with keeping the offender close to home so that there is continued involvement with the family and some sort of supportive environment of a community to, hopefully, help the...integrate the offender back into that community once the term is over. And so we may want to consider using more of our resources towards community justice rather than in a work camp. There have been...I've had conversations with several people on the floor about the changes that we've had in the numbers of individuals and our backlog in...since we adopted the new correctional facility and the work camp, and whether we...it is justified to be putting all of these additional resources into facilities at this time. So I would be glad to answer any questions, but I brought this amendment largely to allow individuals to have the opportunity to talk about the amount that we're spending and whether it's best spent in the way that we have currently on the table.
