SENATOR BROWN: And 5 million, yes.

SENATOR HILGERT: Okay, and we still need 11.2, so we're still \$2.2 million difference between the two projects assuming that the facility needs is fully funded that Senator Thompson illuminated earlier. Is that correct?

SENATOR BROWN: And that the...so the facilities master plan would need to determine priorities and address the needs in the order that they are...are the most pressing.

SENATOR HILGERT: Thank you. Thank you very much, Senator, and I understand Senator Wehrbein's comments regarding the broken faith. I will just make this observation that my predecessor, Senator John Cavanaugh, was instrumental in establishing the Peter Kiewit Conference Center in my district, and that was fully funded. It was a commitment of the State Legislature. We put that together and, frankly, now priorities have changed and now UNO is looking at the usage of that conference center and deciding whether, in fact, that still needs to be operating or to what extent. They are looking at the services offered there. So I hate to say it but sometimes things change, and we...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR HILGERT: ...deal with that. So...but I understand that that is some time ago, and this was a commitment just made very recently. So it is somewhat apples and oranges, but I did want to somehow during this budget discussion talk about the Peter Kiewit Conference Center which I would certainly like to see stay open in my district. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Hilgert. Senator Engel, on AM1501.

SENATOR ENGEL: Mr. Lieutenant Governor and members of the body, again, I'd like to reiterate that two years ago this was a good concept and it still is a good concept.
