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SENATOR VRTISKA: Well, and I certainly support the idea of getting underway. The quicker that we can get it done the better. But, I guess, my point in bringing it up is at the present time what you really need then is some funds to start this process and get the process in place. You can't do those things until all of these things are done. And so to appropriate money to build now isn't even in the realm of what can be done, until you have a complete plan in place, and a master plan, and a program statement and everything that goes with it. So my thinking is that, sure, we need to probably come up with some idea, and apparently you're doing it, to come up with some funding. In the meantime, we go back to the issue of about where are we going to go with the issue? And I listened to Senator Wehrbein, or Senator Wehrbein, Senator Wickersham and Senator Schimek, and I share their frustration. We made a commitment, and I guess if I were on the other side and they had built a prison out at McCook, and decided to build a work camp at Tecumseh, I'd be talking like Senator Baker. He made a commitment and I think Senator Schimek...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR VRTISKA: ...somewhat acknowledge you make a commitment. Do you turn around, as Senator Wickersham said, on a dime and say, well, sorry buddies, it's not going to happen, and you leave everybody? And particularly in this case because there is an issue in this state of east versus west. We all know it happens. Many things do happen in the eastern part of the state that don't happen in the western part of the state. And is it fair at this juncture to say, too bad folks, we changed our mind, and you're left, and that's tough luck, take it, you don't have to like it, but you got to take it? And even though I originally had said I would support the Brown amendment, I'm concerned, unless we can somehow resolve this issue, that what we committed at one time in this Legislature to say we wanted to build a work camp, no, we didn't say we were going to build it in McCook, but somebody decided that's where it was going to be built. And if they would have said they were going to build it in my district, I would be thinking the same thing that I'm sure some...
