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SENATOR CHAMBERS: On...on...

SENATOR JANSSEN: Well, what about...who...you know, I never seen a...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: This is on the boot camp, not the prison.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right. All right, boot camp.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR JANSSEN: I've never seen a study yet that didn't cost some money. Where...could any money that is for the boot camp be used on that study then?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I don't know why we would need to give money for that. I think the Department of Corrections could, through its budget, if it needs to expend any money, absorb that.

SENATOR JANSSEN: So then...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's my opinion.

SENATOR JANSSEN: So in your opinion then, whatever the cost of that study, would come...the cost would come from the Department of Corrections, out of their budget. Is that correct?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, and if, when this amendment is adopted, as I hope it will be, the Director would determine that something more is needed to conduct this study than I think, then the...he could let me know and then I would approach the Legislature. But I'm not aware of any great amount that it would cost.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Would you have a problem if that did happen with them using some of the money that's set aside for the boot camp...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...for the study, it runs into depth and so on?
