SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, I wouldn't. I wouldn't mind that at all. I'm not opposed to it. I just didn't think that it was necessary, but maybe it is.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Well, if it would be, I'd just like to have that on the record that...

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...some of that money could be used in...just in that study.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, we would have to make that...well, yeah, because this says there can be no expenditures for construction.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Um-hum, but there could be for a study.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: We can find out if the language is drafted in a such a way that that would be allowable.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Well, I imagine if we can find 5 million bucks in a couple hours, why,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Laugh)

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...we could probably...(laugh)...we could probably find enough money for a study on the feasibility of that boot camp...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...being...where it should be located.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yeah, I think the money is available, but I'm just saying I want to be sure that under the language, as drafted, that the department would be able to go into this money for the purpose of the study,...

SENATOR JANSSEN: Okay.
