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SENATOR BAKER: What...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, Senator Baker.

SENATOR BAKER: ...what are we going to do here? I tried to follow along on that. The study itself is going to say this is why we sited it there, or what...what do you expect to...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, the pur...

SENATOR BAKER: ...derive out of this study?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: To determine where the best place is to locate the camp in order that it can achieve the purposes, the correctional purposes, intended.

SENATOR BAKER: Well, we, having participated in some of the prison selection studies and what not, we did do that out there. We, you know, we had a survey of the area as to support by the citizens and so on and suitability, the cost of the site, which is...has been purchased. Excuse me. That site has been purchased out there, and the support of the college. There's educational considerations taken into effect there. The college agreed they would work with postsecondary education and, likewise, the secondary education people, working on GEDs and so on. There was also a lot of discussion about potential work for these people and I believe somebody pointed out this afternoon that the Game and Parks were in the middle...I think there's, what, there's five major, I say major, lakes out there that these people could actually do some constructive work rather than going out and picking up trash and what not, build things and maintenance. And the medical support, I know that was brought into the discussion. The hospital there is within three minutes, I believe, of this site. There were all sorts of factors that actually were a carryover of the prison study that adapted well to the work camp site, and I really don't know that it's going to change anything. We...we had an exhaustive study and valuation (sic) and so on with the prison situation and I think that's why it was made...the decision made so quickly that it was that these people in the area, and the city of McCook in particular, were in support of the prison and it was a vote of the city council, I believe, to accept the work camp.
