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up there. Then any of these "tinkerings" that we would do are not objected to by me, but I didn't want to seem to be loading down an amendment with so many specifics that people might wonder what it is I'm really trying to do.

SENATOR ENGEL: That's why I'm asking...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The way it's drafted now makes it clear that the review will be undertaken and I think we could...if we need to add language then we could do that to make it clear that the director would make the decision.

SENATOR ENGEL: Well, I'd certainly be in favor of that and I would support that. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Engel. Senator Chambers, on your amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, and to Senator Baker, at this point I don't want to be argumentative, Senator Baker, but the study you...you talked about in the survey dealt with the prison. I'm going to say again what I have said several times and others have mentioned, but I'm going to do it by analogy. One thing that let people know that that shark in "Jaws" was not real was that those little creatures that look like eels that swim along wherever you find sharks and will attach themselves to sharks were not found with that big old make-believe shark. So the prison was the shark. The boot camp, the work camp, were those little...was to be that little creature that follows the shark. If the shark is not there, you don't find the little creature. So the study was undertaken to determine whether the prison ought to be located there. The understanding in the Legislature was that this boot camp would be located near the prison facility. Since the prison was not put in McCook, anything that had been done there was rendered nugatory, so to speak, as far as the boot camp is concerned. Now the review that will be undertaken will be done by the professionals. I want to get politics out of it as much as possible. The idea of having the report submitted to the Executive Board is so that the Legislature will know on what bases the decision was taken. But, nevertheless, the decision will be made, in my opinion it
