buried in the past, and a pile of sawdust, and a place where they had a wood mill. And this amendment was brought to me by a very close friend of mine, Randy Thomas, a Native American who is...lives here in Lincoln. And what it asks is that we put a historical marker at Fort Robinson commemorating the burial site where these Native Americans, killed during the Cheyenne Outbreak in 1879. The Historical Society has stated that they would need this \$2,500 to construct such a marker, and that they would work with the Game and Parks Commission and the Cheyenne Tribe to draft appropriate language for the marker. This amendment does nothing more than provide for that marker, and has the support of the Historical Society, the Game and Parks Commission, and the Northern Cheyenne Tribe. I urge your support for this amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Pedersen. We're open for discussion on the Pedersen AM1516 to LB 663. Seeing no discussion, Senator Pedersen, or...he waives closing. The question before the body is, shall the Pedersen amendment to LB 663 be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Pedersen's amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Pedersen amendment is adopted to LB 663. Seeing no further lights, Senator Wickersham, did you wish to...?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Just one other comment, Mr. President, and that is that reconstruction of the barracks, the Cheyenne Outbreak Barracks at Fort Robinson, is endorsed and supported by the Northern Cheyenne Tribe. And I hope it's endorsed and supported by you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. The question before the body is, shall LB 663 be advanced to E & R Initial? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who wish to? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 663.
