that you're not doing the right thing? Those people probably made a very honest mistake. But you're going to act as a judge today and the issue is do you follow the rule of law or don't you, and if you don't then there is really no rule to follow. And sometimes the law is harsh, but it also does apply to everybody, and the precedent that you set is one we're going to have to live with. I'd hope you'd reconsider.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Chambers, on the motion to reconsider.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I'm glad that Senator Bromm made his motion to reconsider, and it gives us an opportunity to not just correct this vote that was taken a few minutes ago, which in my opinion was unwise, but it puts us in a position to not have to continually go through these kind of debates from now on when those who bring their claims can point back to today and say, you gave it to those business people, you gave it to them; they made bad business decisions, they chose to try to cut corners by not hiring somebody to do their taxes, so now you've got to give me mine. And then there will be all kinds of attempts to change the meanings of words to say what actually happened did not happen, when we'll know good and well that we created a box and put the Legislature into it. This one vote to give these people this money back can cause immeasurable mischief. Maybe those who would vote for such a claim would feel good after they did that. They'd be able to call that person and say I voted for you and you get your money, but that does not end it. It ends it for him because he got a windfall. How many other people have been cut off? Even myself, I'm kind of slothful as far as filing for my federal income tax, because I always have something coming back. I found out that the way I've been filing my taxes, because I'm not an expert, I could have gotten more back than what I got. But I can't go back beyond a certain date, so I don't even write to them and tell them I'm going to take it to Congress and ask Kerrey and "Hagging" and these other people to tell Congress, pass a special bill for me so I can get some money because I was not attentive and didn't file for this, but I'm as poor as a church mouse and I need that money, so pass a law in Congress to give it to me.
