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PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Do I see five hands? I see five hands. The question is...Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. President, you might recall that there was initial discussion of the committee amendments before they were...before amendments were offered. We've been on the committee amendments at least twice and, for that reason, I think there's been sufficient debate.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Okay. I...so I...we have a...Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: I thought perhaps that you could hear me without the microphone. Since we are on the reconsideration, asking people to change their mind, it's a new question.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator, I believe there has been sufficient debate on Floor Amendment 130. You may challenge the Chair, of course. Question is, shall debate cease? Mr. Speaker, for what purpose do you rise?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Point of clarification and order, Mr. President. Could you explain precisely what portion, I think there's some confusion and I'd just like a clarification from the Chair as to what exactly the question's been called on and what portion they're going to be asked to vote on if the question is called.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Yes, sir, we have divided committee amendments. The first section of the divided committee amendments was Floor Amendment 130, which was line 7 through 12 of the committee amendments. The motion to reconsider was to reconsider Floor Amendment 130. We now have the question before us to cease debate on Floor Amendment 130. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. The question is to cease debate on Floor Amendment 130. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 11 nays to cease debate.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Debate is ceased. To close on Floor Amendment 130, Senator Vrtiska, you're recognized to close on Floor Amendment 130.
