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that's not this issue. This issue is simply there is a law that says that if you use it strictly for agriculture purposes, which, by the way, this is a plane that is used strictly, it has...doesn't...it doesn't carry passengers. It only carries the type of chemicals that are used to spray on crops, and so that is the purpose of this airplane. The same as a combine is used to cut wheat or to cut or pick corn, this is used to protect the crop while it's growing. So, to me, this issue is completely different from the other and the fact that Senator Bohlke has already pointed out, the issue is, in my opinion, and I think it was shared by the committee, fact is the state participated in this error. This person, maybe you could say, well, should have gone and looked it up, but how many of you do not take the fact when the state tells you something and question it? You feel that you've gotten the accurate information and you go from there, and that's what these people did. And I think if there was ever a reason that you should vote to repay this person this money, this is...this is a case here that I think is unquestionably...these people are entitled to a rebate because the state participated in this error that they are now asking us, as a body of reasonable people, to correct. And, with that, I would hope that you would vote to allow this claim to be repaid to these people, because I truly and sincerely believe it's legitimate. With that, thank you very much.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Senator Chambers, Floor Amendment 131.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I don't know to whom Senator Coordsen was referring and, to a lesser extent, Senator Smith, when they suggested that it's being said that people don't have a right to bring these claims or that the Legislature does not have the power to grant these claims. I never said that. I never said any law is violated if the Legislature grants a claim. I never said any citizen is doing anything inappropriate by bringing the claim. None of those things did I say. Here is what I said, in effect. The Legislature is established as the place where people who have claims which they cannot have honored any place else can bring to see if they can persuade the Legislature to grant them what they request. My argument is, from that point onward, that we,
