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difference in the way these particular women were treated as a result of the assault that they underwent, and as a result the judgments were based on that kind of issue. And I would again ask for your support for advancing this bill for the purpose of paying these claims. With that, I'll turn the rest of my time over to Senator Kristensen.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Kristensen.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Not to belabor the point, a similar situation, procedurally. These cases have all had settlements made. They are contingent upon this, but again they are the issues. These are, however, residents of the Hastings Regional Center. All four of these suffered similar torts committed against them. And they have a little different procedure, and I cannot tell you if these amounts...I've not dealt with this type of case, so I...the settlement amounts, however, I think we could have been liable for more, and would be if we went to trial. I would hope that we would approve these claims as well.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Chambers, on FA140.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I just want to correct "Senator Marx", he said Groucho, but I believe that young Senator Bruning was referring to Karl, with a K. But I'm of...that...that's...oh, somebody said, Harpo, that's what the Speaker said. But at any rate, I'm talking about Senator Tyson, for the sake of the transcribers and anybody in the future who may read what we were talking about here. Senator Tyson, when I ran for Attorney General, I ran against a much better man than your present Attorney General. I ran against a man named Paul...I almost said Paul Bunyon, Paul...Paul Douglas. And I was the one who authored an impeachment resolution against him for his inappropriate conduct in connection with whatever that was...Commonwealth. And the Legislature voted to impeach. The Supreme Court voted to convict, four to three. But since the constitution requires a super majority, the minority of three judges prevailed. So the Legislature voted to impeach, four out of the seven justices voted to convict. That's the way I operate, Senator Tyson, I
