would never be made on other projects. We've been told that the business community is solidly behind this. They're making all kind of pledges. Well with all the revenue that's to be generated, and they can issue their revenue bonds, which will be retired by that revenue that's going to be generated, and all these private entities, like the World Herald, the Chamber of Commerce members and all those who want it and have always been opposed to any money being spent on the infrastructure of south Omaha and northeast Omaha can ante up some money, since it's going to benefit them. It's not going to benefit the poor people of Omaha.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It's in Senator Hilgert's district. But putting something in a district doesn't mean it's going to benefit the people there. Many millions of dollars were brought to Omaha through this so called River Front Development. And you know how they get a lot of money into Omaha? They talk about the terrible, deplorable conditions that exist in the poor parts of Omaha. Then when the money comes in, it's spent downtown, but not in those poor areas. That's where the justification for federal money has been pinned. So I'm prepared to fight this to the death of either the bill or myself. (Laugh)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I would ask for a division of the question in terms of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is divisible. We have worked that out. So, members, if you will...if I could have your attention, I'll go through that while it's being put onto the machine. First, there will be six parts to the divided amendment. The first part will be Sections 1 and 2, that deal with the intent and the findings. So part one is Section 1 and 2. Part two will be Sections 3 through 8, that deal with qualifications. So part two of the divided question will be Sections 3 through 8. Part three will be Sections 9 and 10, which deal with the financial aspects. Part three is Sections 9 and 10. Part four is Section 11, which will stand on its own,
