SENATOR BEUTLER: So you could have a separate multiplier for each of the three factors?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes. In fact that...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: ...it would be...I think it would be the expected result.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. That was one question. With regard to the third component, spending by participants,...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Um-huh.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...I wanted to compare that definitional language to language that appears on page 4, Senator, looking at the bottom page pagination again, up in the first line 15, and subsection (2), that begins shortly before that it says, determine the amount of attributable revenue, this is what the board is to do with the application form, one of the items that it is to accomplish; determine the amount of attributable revenue with regard to the construction, that means the first component that's in the definition.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Um-huh.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Employment, renaming the second component of the definition, and then it says, and out of state participants...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Um-huh.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...attending conventions. And I'm not quite putting that all together in my mind. Is...for purposes of determining attributable revenue, are we to multiply the spending by all participants, or spending by out-of-state participants only?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Senator, I believe it would be consistent if page 2, line 10 was amended by putting the words
