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SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And starting in line 1 we have "eligible facility". Are you with me?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And it says what it means, "any publicly owned convention"...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Um-huh.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ..."and meeting center facility", and these are the words I'm interested in, "acquired or completed or substantially reconstructed or expanded", that is an eligible facility, right?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All right. Now would you go to page 4, and in lines 6 and 7, we're talking about what this...how this...what...how this thing came into the hands of the political subdivision.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Um-huh.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It's a facility which the subdivision has acquired, constructed, or operated. That's a different series from the words in the part dealing with an eligible facility, isn't that true?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That is, but it is tied in, because on line 8 it goes on to say...there's a conjunctive, "and operate eligible facilities".

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, you said "and operate", didn't you?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But, if you go up to line 7, it says "or operated", which is disjunctive.
