SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Says, the Convention Center Facility Financing Act shall terminate on June 1st, 2002, if no applications for assistance have been approved prior to that date. So, if no applications have been approved, the language seems clear to me. If an application has been approved, does that...is there no practical question there, or does that mean the act does not terminate?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: I wouldn't say that that means the act does not terminate. I don't know that we need to state that in the positive that it would continue. But that may be comfort language that someone might wish to have.

SENATOR BEUTLER: But it would be the intent that it would not terminate.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so additional projects could be...applications for additional projects could come in.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, thank you.
