involve, say for a convention center. What sorts of job would you envision would be created?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: They are largely, I would believe, service jobs, particularly in food service, laundry services.

SENATOR RAIKES: So I might find that there would be additional jobs for people who would serve food in restaurants and possibly care for rooms in hotels, that sort of thing?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: And the kinds of jobs it takes to maintain a large facility.
