PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to reconsider the vote just taken.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Wickersham, I'd like to renew my discussion with you. Do you have the location where we were, on page 3, starting in line 11, on this new regional, national, and so forth event?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.
