SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Now it says, at which 50 percent of the participants are registered from a location outside Nebraska. Now this definition simply tells us how you will determine whether it's one of these types of events. And I'm not going to ask you what we mean by regional, national and the rest of it. But do you agree that the only thing this definition does is tell us how we determine whether it's one of these kind of events?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes, an event that would be qualified to count toward...or from which you would derive attributable revenue, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Now when we get to the definition of participant, in line 17...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...it says a participant means a person registered to attend and shown to have attended. Above the person doesn't have to have attended in order to qualify this gathering as one of these kinds of events. But in order for this person to count as a participant for the purpose of collecting from the state, the person not only has to have registered, but has to be shown to have attended.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Um-huh.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do you agree?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So, there is a looser requirement to determine what kind of event it is than there is to determine which participants will count toward being able to recoup something from the state. Would you agree?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, then tell me how you disagree.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Okay. I think that the definition of
