participant has a different function. In subsection (9), a participant in that context is one that you would use for the calculation of attributable income. There is an expectation they would have spent X number of dollars in a specified fashion, that would have generated a multiplier in some amount.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I agree.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: The...the definition in subsection (8) is whether or not the event qualifies at all, so that you then look at the participants to find out how many actually showed up.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I agree, that's what I said the...the...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yeah, oh, I'm sorry, Senator, but I didn't under...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, what I'm trying to show is that when you want to determine that it's one of these kind of events all you have to show is that so many people from outside Nebraska...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...have registered...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and they don't have to attend for that purpose.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct, but you don't get any credit, so to speak.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right, that's why I took us down to participant.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The participant must not only have registered but also have attended.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.
