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PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...you get to the multipliers, isn't it?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But when we're talking about the basic, it all starts with, as you said, "welcome, sucker". No, you said "welcome, stranger"...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Welcome...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and Senator Beutler said "sucker", so I put them together. Well, the suckers who come from outside Nebraska are going to be the triggering mechanism for everything we're talking about, and if nobody from outside Nebraska comes, none of this is operational. Is that right?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: If you don't get people from out-of-state, you're not going to get a qualified event. And if you don't get a qualified event, you're not going to get any money.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right, and if the event is not qualified then participants, whether within the state or outside the state, will not count toward attributable income.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I think my time is up, the President told me.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator, you may continue.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, and I'm going to give Senator Wickersham a chance to do some of the work that he was doing over there before I ask more...oh, then I have some more questions. I thought you were going to be doing something that I was taking you from. Senator Wickersham.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Wickersham, would you yield?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Oh, yes.
