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page 4, lines 16 and 19; page 5, line 15; page 6, lines 13 and 17; page 8, line 29...I got...I lost my place. I might have to go back and start again, but I don't think I will. Page 10, line 7; page 11, lines 2, 17, 19, and 22; page 12, lines 4, 11, 13, 15, and 18, strike "assistance" and insert "subsidization", then in parentheses, using upper and lower case where appropriate. There's at least one point in the bill where the word "assistance" begins a sentence. So that's what the amendment would do. And since it's not that difficult to grasp, I want to engage Senator Wickersham, whose amendment we're dealing with, the committee amendments, in some additional discussion.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Wickersham, I would like to go to page 5. Now, subsection (b) or subdivision (b), starting on line 3: "The estimated number of participants and the estimated amount of the spending impact of these participants on attributable revenue",...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Um-hum.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...did Senator Beutler discuss this specific provision here when he was questioning you about participants and attributable income?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: I...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You wouldn't mind discussing it again with me even if he had, would you?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: No, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: But I don't believe that he did because this is in the application section and I believe that he was discussing provisions that were in the actual counting section.
