SENATOR CHAMBERS: Exactly. In this section, we are informing people who file an application what they must include and we're letting those on the board know what they must find in that application.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now we don't know for sure here today what "participant" really refers to, do we, with certitude?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Well, it is the estimated number of persons who are...would meet the definition in subsection (9) of Section 3.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And when we were talking about that participant in subsection (9), we weren't sure whether that meant a person from outside of Nebraska or a person within Nebraska once you had 50 percent or more from outside Nebraska registering.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That would count toward attributable income, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All right. Now when we go back to (9), it says: "Participant means a person registered to attend and shown to have attended", I take that to mean the outsiders, the "fureigners". You said Senator Landis, and maybe others, feel that once you qualify this as the event by enough from outside Nebraska just registering, you wouldn't really have to have any of those people attend that registered. Once you have an international, regional or national event established by a registration of more than 50 percent, and I don't know how you're going to determine the total number who are from outside of Nebraska, since they don't have to actually attend...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Well, they have to register.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But they don't have to attend, so how do we know...so it's more than 50 percent of those who register, right?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: More than 50 percent would have to be from
