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SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...to give even more money.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And not one soul from outside Nebraska...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...had actually attended.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes. On the other hand, if you interpret the language of the bill to mean that one-half of the attendees had to be from out of state, then you don't obtain that result.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But we're not sure that that's the way you have to do it under the language of the bill now.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That may be ambiguous, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I think my time is up, or is it? Is my time up?

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Five seconds.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, it's up.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: For discussion on Floor Amendment 135 to Floor Amendment 147 to LB 80...382, excuse me, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. And, Mr. President, as I stated, I'm trying to make a record and I want all these confusing things to be in the record and I want it to be clear that this is a flimflam bill. Now those who have worked on this thing for all those months and years to get a convention center, do you think they haven't considered what I'm talking about now; that they haven't figured a way to skirt the constitution and skirt the laws? Omaha is famous for that. I was able to stop them on the red lights. Now they got cops and others stealing money that should go to the schools, but I'm going to try to get those thieves brought in line too. This is a little different because we have the pillars of the community involved in this one.
