SENATOR CHAMBERS: I believe so, yes, I used...I talked about it in both places...but three is...

SENATOR LANDIS: I think, yes. Okay, let me tell you...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR LANDIS: ...my reading of that. The word "participants" in line 13 is, it's true that there it's used as the qualifying determinant of what is or is not a regional conference...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right.

SENATOR LANDIS: ...and it does talk about registration there. However, the use of the word "participants" I think is illuminated by its meaning in (9), which is somebody who registered and attends. In other words, if there's slippage in line 13 between somebody who registers but does not attend, they are, in fact, not a participant. The only way they're a participant is if they meet the standard of subsection (9), which is the definition of a "participant", which is somebody who not only registers but also attends.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right, I'm with you on that.

SENATOR LANDIS: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But, Senator Landis, based on what happens in line 8...

SENATOR LANDIS: Yeah.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...are you saying that the only ones who can qualify as participants for determining attributable income or revenue would be people from outside of Nebraska?

SENATOR LANDIS: No. Can I expand a little bit here?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes,...
