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in Nebraska, and we tell each one of these people we'll give you 50 cents just for doing this?

SENATOR LANDIS: Norm...I will tell you this. I don't always feel the same about a reconsideration motion as to others, but I'll entertain this discussion for awhile. I'd like to get us on to an actual amendment, because I think we're moving forward then. But let me...let me respond to that, because that's a fair question.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, actually, if you saw how many amendments I have, you see we're not going anywhere. Doesn't matter what we discuss.

SENATOR LANDIS: (Laugh) I know we aren't. I know we are.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR LANDIS: I regard one as a more legitimate tactic than the other, but...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, I see what you mean.

SENATOR LANDIS: ...okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR LANDIS: We have a...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, Senator Landis...

SENATOR LANDIS: ...working model.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I will wait until I have an amendment up there because I don't want to get you into that area, because I know that has been your position.

SENATOR LANDIS: I want to be helpful, but I also...also want to relate what I think is good faith...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Exactly.
