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and I said how come we ended up in an altogether different area of Nemaha County than we picked from. Do you know what their answer was? Their answer was we couldn't buy land over there where you guys picked it so we went where we could buy it. I felt like we'd been fooled from day one because the primary interest in where to get the land was where somebody would sell it to them. Obviously, they weren't able to condemn it, they had to buy it, and they had to go where they could buy it. Now I don't know whether the site in Nemaha County was good or bad, but I can tell you right now, it wasn't any site that we picked. If that same thing happened in Boyd County, I would suggest that there again they probably found a place that they could buy land and not where maybe it was decided it was even the best. And the ultimate ending in this story is it appears to me that the site that they picked must have been about the worse that they could find up there from all of the remarks and the information that's been gathered over the years since that siting was done. So was it...where was the bad faith? Well, I can tell you, you go back to the bad faith, it was in the way the whole decision was handled and I don't know why, first of all, we spent any time even trying to determine if they are going to buy la...if they were going to go buy a site that was sellable or salable as opposed to what supposedly was suppose to be a scientific method to come about a siting, a place that could be sited. I just think you need to know that because it was to me the most disappointing process that I've ever gone through, and it's one of the reasons I totally and wholly opposed every siting in Nemaha County for the simple reason that I didn't think that the process...I thought the process was flawed if for no other reason for that reason alone. With that, I'll give the rest of my time to Senator Brashear if he'd like to have it.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Excuse me. One minute. Senator Brashear, one minute.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. President, members of the body, thank you very much, Senator Vrtiska, because once I complete this, I'm not trying to encumber this record or take time just to be doing it, but I feel I owe a contribution to the body. I had indicated that a number of facts have significantly changed since we got the opinion of independent counsel, and I particularly appreciated the focus which Senator Kristensen
