SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Chambers asked for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unexcused senators please report to the Chamber. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor, the house is under call. Would senators please check in. Senator Bohlke, Senator Lynch, and Senator Matzke, please check in, please. The house is under call. Senator Stuhr, Senator Thompson, Senator Suttle, the house if under call. All unexcused senators please check in. Senator Bohlke, Senator Lynch, Senator Matzke. The house is under call. Senator Chambers says we can proceed. There has been a request for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1767-68.) 39 ayes, 8 nays on the advancement of LB 530, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 530 is advanced to E & R for engrossing. I do raise the call. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, I do have some items. Hearing notice from Health and Human Services and a Reference report. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1768-1769.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, next agenda item. (LB 216)
