CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the motion to advance LB 630A.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, General File.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first bill, 382 by Senator Lynch and others. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 13, referred to Revenue. The bill was advanced to General File. Committee amendments were offered, Mr. President, on April 28. At that time, there was a division of the committee amendments. The first component was offered of that divided committee amendment. Senator Chambers had moved to amend that component, Mr. President, with FA136. That motion failed. I now have pending from Senator Chambers a motion to reconsider the vote on FA136 to the first component of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. To begin, why don't we have Senator Landis maybe give us a brief update on the bill, if you'd like.

SENATOR LANDIS: Sure. Senator Chambers was amending and reconsidering and amending and reconsidering. That's where we were.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Landis. For discussion on the motion to reconsider, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, Mr. President and members (speaking in hoarse voice)...I found it.
