PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The motion to reconsider is not successful.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. Enrollment and Review reports  
LB 880, LB 878, LB 879, LB 873, LB 876, LB 877, LB 489, LB 860,  
LB 663, LB 664, LB 805, LB 805A, and LB 882 to Select File, some  
of those having Enrollment and Review amendments. And,  
Mr. President, Enrollment and Review also reports LB 548A and  
LB 689 as correctly engrossed. (Legislative Journal  
pages 1792-1795.)

Mr. President, the next amendment to this component of the  
committee amendments, Senator Chambers. Senator, I have what  
I'm calling FA147, starts on page 1, line 7.
