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SENATOR LANDIS: The Legislature will appropriate out of that, out of the General Fund into another source.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh...

SENATOR LANDIS: But it goes first to the General Fund.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, and then it will not be taken out of the General Fund to be put into this other fund.

SENATOR DIERKS: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It just means that amount of money is available to be appropriated from the General Fund. So taxes are going to be collected as always.

SENATOR LANDIS: That's right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then an attempt will be made to identify what percentage of those taxes should go for this convention center. Then the Legislature may choose to appropriate that amount, but it also may choose not to.

SENATOR LANDIS: Every word of that is true.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And since I only have a minute, I'll put my light on, because there's another question I have to ask you on that score.

SENATOR DIERKS: Senator Chambers, your light is on, but you've spoken three times. You're recognized to close.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. And, Senator Landis, if I don't finish, I assure you I'll get the time. This question won't take a long time for you to answer. When we talk about this multiplier, let's not, at this point, try to figure out how they're going to arrive at all of that through this board's, I call them machinations, I probably say "makinations", if you...

SENATOR LANDIS: I do.
