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all to do what I'm doing. All I need to do is understand English and determine, as I read the words here, whether the words express the idea that they are designed to express. When I see the sentence structure is wrong, when I see them talking about how many votes you need to do something, just reading English and understanding English puts me in good shape to do what I'm doing. Why didn't anybody else come up with these things? Suppose I had just gone to sleep, like all the other senators from Omaha and all the other little chickadees and crumb-snatchers, who have been bribed with 30 percent of what is not going to come from this bill, if I had just sat back like the rest of you and let it go, do you see what kind of legislation you'd have on the books? And how often do I do this? And people get irritated, don't they. I didn't broker this deal. I didn't write a word in this. And when I offer words that would help, you've got your marching orders, and you better not accept any of them. And I love that, because I have won. I own this Legislature, and I've often said it, I dictate what this Legislature will do. You've got a bill here talking about a \$210 million project, creating a new method of kicking back tax money to political subdivisions, and I dictate the fact that you cannot accept an amendment to this badly crafted bill. Senator Landis has pointed out that the Revenue Committee is not guilty of drafting the language in these findings that I've been dealing with. However, the law talks about conspirators, it talks about accessories, it talks about aiders and abettors, and not one of these categories of persons has to do anything as far as a concrete act. It used to be that you had to do something that advanced the project. That's not so under the law of Nebraska anymore. So, we have conspirators, aiders and abettors, and putting together one of the very bad pieces of legislation that will come before us. And it must remain bad. If I offer an amendment that I think you all are going to accept, I'm going to pull it before we take a vote, but I won't have to do that, because you got your marching orders. And your marching orders dictate what you must do on this bill, just like I dictate the fact that you cannot vote for an amendment, well a couple of you voted for a couple of the amendments, but I mean in general. And we all understand what's happening here today and what will happen the rest of the day. And there are people going around with their little cards, trying to count how many people are going to vote for cloture. I don't care. Get
