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not a tax cut measure. This is a tax shift measure in a way, if the chickadees get anything. But they are so willing to sell out or needed to be shown a way to placate the big shots in Omaha that they were told, we'll promise you this, you ain't going to get nothing, but you can tell your constituents and others that you voted for this bill because you thought you were going to get something out of the pot of \$32 million. I don't know where they get that figure. And that's another part of the flimflam that my non-Omaha colleagues are working on their constituents. And I'm going to do everything I can to show that that is a hoax also. That is not a reason to support this bill. And if the people outside of Omaha are going to take that kind of a deal as an example of how they get a fair cut out of things involving Omaha where Omaha gets the whole bakery, then your constituents are going to see how unbright you really are, and how little you sell out the rest of the state for. Omaha gets 70 percent of maybe nothing, and y'all get 30 percent of nothing. Your song ought to be, Senator Chris Peterson, (singing) we'll get plenty of nothing. But y'all aren't going to do that because y'all don't sing. There was this judge presiding over a case where a poor widder woman's home was to be taken from her, and the jury came in with a verdict against...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...against the widder woman, and the judge set the verdict aside. And when all those big shots looked at the judge for an explanation, he said, when you're going to steal from a widder woman in this court, it takes more than twelve people to do it; it takes thirteen and you'll never get the thirteenth vote, meaning the judge. Well, although the people in other parts of the state may wind up being stolen from with the complicity and approval of their consti...of their representatives, I will at least try to alert those people to what is being done, that this bill constitutes a bill of goods and everybody familiar with the mechanics of it will know exactly what this bill is and what it is not.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers, you're recognized to continue.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. When I looked at
