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PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Raikes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Based on what you just pointed out, there is going to be a period of time during which the political subdivision is going to have to bear the cost of everything that is done in connection with acquiring, constructing, substantially reconstructing, operating, equipping, and all these other things? Is that true?

SENATOR RAIKES: I think that's correct, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do we have any idea how long a period that will be, other than to say that there must be at least one convention held before the state can expect to have to give up some money to this?

SENATOR RAIKES: I...I don't, but I'll be happy to try to find that information.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, let's say that we know so that I can get to the point where the state is going to kick in something. There has to have been at least one convention, would you agree,...

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...to give a basis for showing something?

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes...no.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: May I ask...

SENATOR RAIKES: I'm...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...Senator Landis a question then, Senator Raikes? Senator Landis.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Landis.
