SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Coordsen, if you can get a copy of the amendment, I would like to invite your attention to page 9 of the amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Page 5.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Page 5, okay, now we're all right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Okay, now.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now would you look at line 18 about the middle of the page.
