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amendment off it, once the adoption of the committee amendments occurred, this bill can work. If it needs to be changed, it can be changed another day even if Senator Chambers was successful this time. His essential argument is this isn't going to work and it's not worth passing and I'll keep you from changing it until it is worth passing is false. If we are not given an opportunity to do the normal kind of cleanup which General File and Select File is normally meant to do, if we're kept from that, that's okay. This amendment can stand on its own. It will result in the process that I've described and we can live with it on its face. It could, undoubtedly, be improved by more careful drafting, and if I have left an impression, an impression to the contrary, I certainly would renounce that. This draft could be improved with some more language and some clarification, but it doesn't need it to be effective, to give the authority that it needs to do and to, essentially, establish a theory that says when a public entity creates a new form of income to the state, that the state can share that back with the public entity that created...
