PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...than on the side trying to uphold it. You know, in the realm of predator and prey, the predator animal has to run faster than the prey animal. The predator does not have to be faster than every individual of the prey category. A cheetah doesn't have to be able to run faster than every gazelle. The cheetah just has to be able to run faster than the specific gazelle which is being pursued. So I don't have to worry about any other bill. All I have to do is worry about this one, LB 382. And, Mr. President, to help us all, I'm going to ask for a call of the house.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is, shall the house go under call? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The house is under call. Would unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Would all unexcused members please return to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Senator Bohlke, could you please check in. Senator Dwite Pedersen. Thank you, Senator. Senator Stuhr. The house is under call. Would members please record your presence. Senator Tyson, Senator Dwite Pedersen, the house is under call. A roll call vote has been requested. Senator Tyson, the house is under call. The question is the adoption of Floor Amendment 156 to the committee amendments of LB 382. Mr. Clerk, please read the roll call, please.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1801.) 42 ayes, 0 nays on the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a priority motion on the desk. Senator Lynch would move to invoke cloture pursuant to Rule 7, Section 10.
