I'm not going to come out against it and say, no, you can't do that, but I think they should have to think about each time they do it, so I'm probably not going to vote for the amendment, Senator Janssen. I just wanted you to know why I feel that way. And I think if you open the door like this then the University of Nebraska will come along and say, hey, how come we can't do this? So thank you.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Well, the...Senator Crosby, if I might answer that...
