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enough to put a restriction in it, I would probably put in about a six restriction. I can't...rather than to draft a hurried amendment maybe in the wrong spot, the wrong place, I'm just going to vote against this, because I do believe that it's going to be very easy to have eight needed events and then ten needed events and pretty quick it will be equivalent of a full-time license on these particular areas. And with the concern that's being expressed all over this country and even at the University of Nebraska, I don't know so much about the privates, I don't want to be on record supporting something like this. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Vrtiska.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. I, too, rise in opposition to this. I think that the speakers ahead of me have portrayed the issue very clearly and that is that we're opening the door to where the...these particular schools will, in fact, be able to serve alcohol any time they want to without having to ask any...ask permission for a special occasion. I think that there's no question in my mind that it will eventually encompass all of the educational institutions of higher learning in the state and I, too, point to the fact that alcohol has become a tremendous problem with our young people in this state and I don't know why we want to stand here in this body and encourage the use of alcohol by our young people when we know that it's not...has no particular benefit for them. Therefore, I have to stand and oppose this amendment. With that, thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the questions that have been asked and answered show me that this amendment may be much broader in scope than had been told to me. I had had weddings mentioned. Every now and then there's a wedding that they have and people like to drink at weddings. Well, I think before they've entered marry...marriage they don't know anything about why they need liquor. They don't need to drink before. They need to drink after. And, see, having been in that institution myself and enjoyed it while I was there, young Senator Smith, but now that I've been sprung I'll never go back again, you talk about deterrence and
